## Child and Adult Care Feeding Program At-Risk Afterschool Sponsor/Site Agreement 2023-2024

This agreement is to outline the expectations from Feeding Southwest Virginia (FSWVA) for each at-risk afterschool feeding site that is not legally affiliated with FSWVA. FSWVA is a sponsor for non-affiliated sites to provide afterschool meals to children between the ages of 1 and 18 during the months school is in session.

The Site Personnel at each CACFP feeding site agrees to abide by the following:

- 1. Serve meals to school-aged children between the ages of 1 and 18 (or persons 19 and over who are mentally or physically disabled and participating in a public or private non-profit school program for the mentally or physically disabled).
- 2. Serve meals that meet the minimum meal pattern requirements.
- 3. Provide adequate supervision during the meal service.
- 4. Provide an educational, recreational, or physical activity each day of the meal service.
- 5. Maintain and submit promptly all reports and records required by FSWVA and as stated in the CACFP Training.
- 6. Report to FASWVA any changes in the number of meals required as attendance fluctuates.
- 7. Report any other problems regarding the meal service within 1 business day.
- 8. Comply with Civil Rights laws and regulations.
- 9. Attend all trainings required by FSWVA.

This agreement is valid between **October 1, 2023 and September 30, 2024**. Meals served outside of this date range are not eligible for reimbursement nor can be considered part of the At-Risk Afterschool food service program. During the period of this agreement, the site may not enter into another agreement with another CACFP Program Sponsor. *If the site elects to discontinue participation in this program, 90 days' notice must be given to Feeding Southwest Virginia in writing.*
